On June 21, 2003, 27 members of the Class of 1953 spent the afternoon at the Whitney Theater visiting, reading the 50th Reunion Yearbook and remembering high school experiences before attending the Fandangle performance that night. Copies of the yearbook were mailed to classmates who were unable to attend.

Out-of-state classmates came from California, Missouri, Arkansas, Oklahoma, New Mexico and North Carolina.

Jon Rex Jones recalled memories of school years during World War II, including the school victory garden and buying U.S. saving bond stamps each week. Then he sang 'God Bless the USA'.

Betty Viertel led the group in remembering events of school days. Sixteen of the 31 graduating seniors started the first grade together. The first grade had 75 students enrolled with 50 in the eighth grade. Twenty-two classmates are deceased.
